There will also be performance opportunities both at Christ Church Cathedral and off-site in the community.

Camp begins at 9 a.m. with early drop off beginning at 8 a.m. for working parents. Breakfast will be served 8:10-8:40 a.m., and lunch and afternoon snack are included.

Dr. Steven Rickards, Camp Director has received international acclaim as one of America's finest countertenors. He sings and teaches internationally. Steven is on the faculty of Butler University, and the University of Indianapolis, where is co-director of the Vocal Arts Institute for Young Singers. Steven sings with the Christ Church Cathedral Choir of Men and Boys.



Amy Eggleston has served as staff coach/accompanist at the University of Indianapolis, where she also teaches diction and directs opera scenes. She is also the accompanist for the Hendricks Symphonic Choir. Amy holds degrees and diplomas from the University of Cincinnati, Indiana University and the Peabody Conservatory.



Nathan Medley, countertenor, pedagogue, and graduate of Oberlin Conservatory, holds degrees in vocal and historical performance. An active performer of early music, the former Houston resident also garners praise as a teacher of high school voices and as an early childhood music educator. In Indianapolis he sings with the Christ Church Cathedral Choir of Men and Boys and is on the faculty of the Vocal Arts Institute at the University of Indianapolis.



Cyndee Giebler, a certified Orff Schulwerk teacher and trainer, recently relocated to Indianapolis after spending a year at the Orff Institut in Salzburg, Austria. Cyndee has worked with the Indianapolis Children's Choir. She is a graduate of the University of Wisconsin and received her masters degree from the University of St. Thomas. In addition to teaching, Cyndee is a published composer. She enjoys composing and arranging music for young musicians. Cyndee also teaches graduate classes at Anderson and DePaul Universities.



Stephen Strugnell, a graduate of Edinburgh University Music Faculty and an arts professional in Scotland for twenty years, Stephen Strugnell is now a piano teacher and writer living in Indianapolis. For many years, he was a member of the Laigh Trio.
