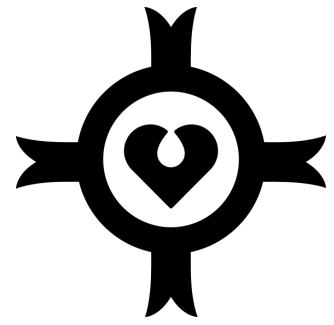


Sunday Announcements, May 30, 2021
